

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Colleges and universities differ in the scores and credit awarded on a CLEP exam. If transferring from Butler to a 4 year college/university, it is the student's responsibility to contact a counselor at that institution prior to taking the exam to determine their CLEP requirements and acceptance of scores and credits. That institution will apply its own policy to your original scaled score rather than transferring the credit Butler has granted. A maximum of 30 hours of CLEP may be applied toward graduation. In order to earn a degree at Butler, a student **must** earn a minimum of **15** credit hours in residence.

A \$77.00 CLEP fee is due at the time of the exam. Forms of payment are credit card, check or money order paid directly to CLEP plus a \$20.00 administrative fee paid to BCC (total cost of exam: \$97.00).

To receive English Comp I credit from Butler, students will take the English Composition w/ Essay. There will be a two week delay for results as CLEP grades the exam. If passed, an additional essay will be required to receive credit from Butler. This second essay will go to Butler's English Department for grading.

### Testing for Credit in English Composition I

The requirement can be satisfied in these ways:

<u>Test</u>	<u>Score &amp; Essay Evaluation</u>	<u>Credit Awarded</u>
* English Composition w/essay	60	3
* Freshman College Composition	50	3
#ACT English	31	3

\*A student must score as high on any given test as the above mentioned scaled score. In addition to the examination, a student must write an essay and submit it to Butler’s English Department for review. If the essay is of substandard quality, no credit will be given for English Composition I for any of the above tests.

# Same grade awarded at completion of Composition II.

\*\* Students cannot test for English Composition II at Butler.

### Testing for Credit in College Algebra or Pre-Calculus Math

*College Algebra credit	31	3
**Pre-Calculus Math	31	3

\*Students must also have completed the equivalent of Algebra II and one year of high school geometry with at least a “B” average.

\*\*Students must also have completed two years of high school algebra, one year of high school geometry, and one-half unit of trigonometry with at least a “B” average.
