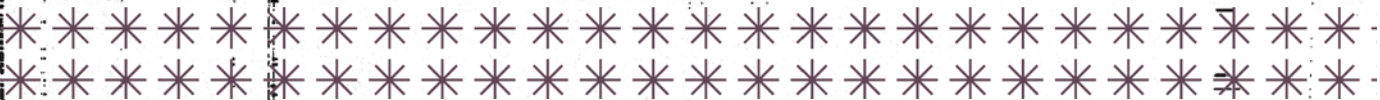

# COMMUNITY EDUCATION

## OUR GOAL

To provide a variety of classes that educate, entertain, and enrich the diverse interests of our communities. If the class or subject you are interested in is not in this listing, please let us know. We are here to serve you!

## FEES

Course fees, payable in full upon enrollment, are listed with each course. Fees are calculated to cover the cost of instruction, supplies and promotion which varies with each course.

## CANCELLATION POLICY

When we cancel or reschedule a class, you will be notified. Therefore, it is extremely important that we have a daytime and an evening telephone number where we may reach you or leave a message.

## REFUND POLICY

We will give a full refund if a class is cancelled. If a student withdraws a fee will be charged. No refund after the class begins.

## PARKING

All students must have a parking permit for their vehicle to attend class on campus. Permits are free and will be mailed to each student one week before class starts.

## CONTINUOUS ENROLLMENT

Enrollment in community education courses is based on a first-come, first-served basis. Pre-enrollment is required. The decision to cancel a class for lack of enrollment is decided one week prior to the start date. We will accept registration up to the starting date of each class. 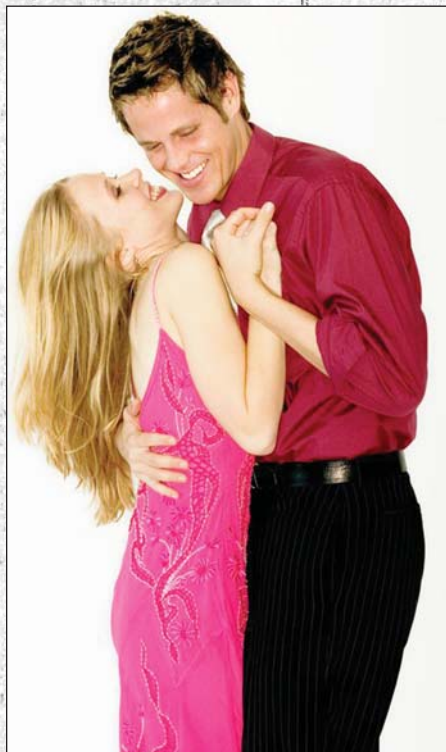

## PRIVATE PILOT GROUND SCHOOL

Have you ever dreamed of being a pilot? This class can get you started on making your dream come true! Instructor Dr. Rob Kuhns, a private pilot and Director of Butler's McConnell campus, will cover topics including navigation, meteorology, radio communication, radio navigation, theory of flight, federal air regulations and related topics. Upon successful completion of the class, the student should be able to pass the FAA private pilot written examination. Interested students can also prepare for the sport pilot exam, which prepares pilots for flying smaller, more recreational aircraft. Each student will be given a six-month subscription to a flight training magazine and may also get a chance to take an introductory flight with a licensed pilot. Kuhns also plans to provide each student with a mentor pilot, who can provide advice to students if they pursue further training at the completion of the Butler course.

## MOTORCYCLE TRAINING COURSES

Butler Community College is glad to partner with Motorcycle Training Specialists Inc. to offer Basic Rider and Experienced Rider Courses.

The Basic Rider Course is aimed at beginning riders ages 15 and older as well as those who are returning to motorcycling. The course includes approximately 8 hours of classroom work and 12 hours of riding instruction. This class will teach the participant how to operate a motorcycle safely, with emphasis on special skills and mental attitude necessary for dealing with traffic. A special segment of the course will show how to create your own strategy for riding in traffic and dealing with critical situations. This course includes both a written and driving test. Certified Rider Coaches will provide instruction to prepare the student for practical riding in a controlled parking lot. You'll smile with satisfaction when the Rider Coach hands you the course completion card. Motorcycles and helmets for class use are included in the course fee. After successful completion of the course, participants will qualify for a Kansas Division of Vehicles - Certificate of Completion and premium discounts with some motorcycle insurers.

Before enrolling in this course participants must be able to balance and ride a bicycle, read, listen and speak English at the sixth grade level. Tuition is \$200.00 per person. Classes are offered weekends starting March 6 at Butler of El Dorado and Andover.

## EXPERIENCED RIDER COURSE

Increasing numbers of seasoned riders are flocking to this five hour course to hone their skills and fine-tune the mental skills needed for survival in traffic. This course will cover protective gear, rider responsibility, motorcycle inspection and care, effects of alcohol and other drugs while riding, risk management, and lane positioning. Using your own motorcycle, you'll put into practice the techniques of managing traction, stopping quickly, cornering and swerving. You may bring a passenger to the class at no additional cost. After successful completion of the course, participants will qualify for premium discounts with some motorcycle insurers.

Before enrolling participants must be a licensed motorcycle operator and able to read, listen and speak English at a sixth grade level. Tuition is \$100.00 per driver. Classes are offered on Saturday, once each month beginning April through October at Butler of El Dorado.

**Award Winners Series**

A novel or collection of stories that wins a major national book award can often be among the most widely read literary works of its day. Sometimes such a selection can be career-making, as in the case of Harper Lee's 1961 Pulitzer Prize for her first and only novel, *To Kill a Mockingbird*. In other cases, the award may seem to be more of a career validation. For example, William Faulkner – one of America's greatest writers – won two Pulitzer Prizes. They were awarded for *A Fable* in 1955, and for *The Reivers* in 1963. These, however, have turned out to be two of the least-read or recognized books of Faulkner's prestigious body of work.

The pervasiveness of the Internet, television, and movies, and the advent of the labyrinth-like commercial chain bookstores can make choosing a book out of the thousands published each year seem like a daunting task. By upholding a standard of literary excellence, the awards can help ensure that the most significant books will find an audience, both in the moment and for years to come.
