STANDING REPORTS

<u>Student Government Association</u> – Christian Lies reported that the SGA has had a very active semester. They celebrated Constitution Day, Do Something Nice Day and will celebrate Thanksgiving by serving warm pie and drinks to faculty, staff and students

next week. They worked with volleyball and soccer to do Pick Out events to raise awareness for breast cancer. They also hosted International Games Day with the library and worked with United Way to put change jars across campus. Their current projects are trying to collect police badges for a young boy in Indiana who was recently diagnosed with cancer and collecting coats with the Grizzly Ambassadors for the local coat drives.

Operational Staff – Katie Zarchan has taken a new position and is no longer able to act as president so they do not have a president at this time. Melody Doyal gave their update and said that their holiday store in October had 21 vendors with gross sales of over \$3300 and resulted in over \$880 in profits for OpStaff. Currently they are holding their annual pie sale. Next month they will adopt 2-3 families in the community to help with a prepaid visa for the holidays.

<u>Board Finance Committee</u> – Trustee Engelbrecht reported the finances are right on track with last year as shown on page 63 of the board book.

<u>Foundation Board Report</u> – November 27th will be their next quarterly meeting where they will continue focus on their visioning process. They have two new members – Pam Cross (who is returning to the board) and Dr. Tom Estep (a new member).

<u>President's Report</u> – Dr. Krull introduced the new Health, Education and Public Safety Dean Christy Streeter and the new Associate Dean of Nursing, Dr. Beth Eagleton. Dr. Eagleton said she was excited to join the Butler campus and had very positive experiences with the Butler nursing students in her previous positions.

Dr. Krull also shared the Veterans Honor Roll (included at the end of the minutes) with over 448 years of service from those who reported to our office. She also mentioned what a great celebration they had in Andover this year in celebration of Veterans Day.

Butler and Augusta USD 402 have partnered and announced the initiative of the Culinary Arts Academy at Augusta High School. The MOUs will be presented to the Board in December for approval and enrollment will begin in the spring with a class of 16 students.
